"TERRA URBANA"

ENIA Gallery presents on **Saturday, 22 November 2025** the solo exhibition of **Tassos Triandafyllou** titled "**TERRA URBANA**".

As the artist states, "the works in the **TERRA URBANA** series are frottage pencil transfers of the shifts and distortions in the structural elements of the urban landscape; these were identified and evaluated as the raw material whose further processing leads to a new reading of the place through the creation of the artwork".

"I imprinted in various forms and versions this thin membrane, the 'skin of the place' that constitutes the boundary between 'below' and 'above', between subterranean and aboveground".

In his text for the exhibition, **Thomas Symeonidis** notes: "His focus falls on what is most common, most public: the pavements. In this way he provides a crucial ground for creating and experimenting with new mechanisms for sensing and reading the city's body. On the surfaces he records one can discern not only a body but a speech, a surface, a depth, and, perhaps most importantly, the sensory code by which human activity and time are inscribed across different scales of material composition".
